“Mrs D van der Walt (DA) to ask the Minister of Arts and Culture”:

Whether the Auckland Park Post Office building in Gauteng was declared a national site; if so, when was it declared a national site?

REPLY:

No, the Auckland Park Post Office building in Gauteng has not been declared a national site because the it has not been graded as such.

In terms of the transitional provisions of the National Heritage Resources Act Section 58 (11)(a) all the sites that were declared in terms of the National Monuments Act of 1969, automatically became grade2 sites (provincial monuments).

Until such time that they are graded, they remain provincial sites.
