In terms of section 1 of the Act –

- (a) “Coat of arms” means any object or figure, being a symbolic representation displayed in colours on a shield in conformity with the principles and rules of heraldry with or without a crown, helmet, crest, mantling, supporters, motto or other accessories;
- (b) “Badge” means any object or figure, being a symbolic representation, but not displayed on a shield, used for official or municipal purposes or by any association, institution or person as a mark of recognition or as a distinguishing token;
- (c) “Other emblem” means any flag, pennant, gonfalon, decoration, medal, seal, insignia of rank, any office or order or other kindred symbolic representation, but does not include a coat of arms or badge.
